The starting materials for these products are mineral, plant (dried or fresh) and animal substances – Arnica is a commonly used active ingredient



Many plants for the use in these medicines are harvested by hand



Silicea Bergkristall - a commonly used active ingredient



The first step in the preparation of a homeopathic medicine from plant or animal starting material is the preparation of the 'mother tincture'
